The Experiment Station has an agreement with the Physical Plant to pick up and dispose of hazardous waste materials. The charges incurred by units in Agriculture for this service will be billed to the Director's Office. Physical Plant will then provide a breakdown of the charges so that they can be distributed to the responsible units.

I received the first "breakdown" recently, and it included charges dating back to June 1993. Because there is no record that this charge has been communicated to the departments, the Director's office will absorb the costs. However, please be aware that effective immediately, the charges for this service in the future will be billed to the "user" units. Please take this into account, as appropriate, in developing your budgeting for the next fiscal year. The attached Policy and Management Guidelines Memorandum effects this policy on January 1, 1995.

TITLE: HAZARDOUS MATERIALS DISPOSAL CHARGES

APPLICATION: Units (academic departments, research and extension centers, institutes and centers) requiring periodic pickup and disposal of hazardous wastes.

RATIONALE: Physical Plant, as a service, picks up and disposes of hazardous waste materials. The charges for this service are charged to the Director's office, becoming an off-the-top budget item. This essentially is spread across all units, regardless of use of the service. The charges should be distributed to the users.

STATEMENT: Charges incurred by the Agricultural Experiment Station for picking up and disposing of hazardous waste materials will be charged back, on a prorated basis, to the user units as they are incurred.
