Young Alumni Award Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food and Life Sciences University of Arkansas

A. Objective of the Award

The objective of the Young Alumni Award is to recognize and honor a distinguished alumnus(a) of the Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food and Life Sciences.

B. Eligibility

- Any alumnus(a) or former student of the Bumpers College may be nominated for this award.
- No previous recipient of this award is eligible.
- No person shall be recommended for this award while a candidate for public office.
- The nominee shall be age 40-years-old or younger.
- The nominee must be available to provide the Alumni Representative address at the Bumpers College spring commencement ceremony.

C. Process of Nomination

- An alumnus(a) may be nominated by the Bumpers College Alumni Society, an individual alumnus(a), any academic department or unit of the College or by an individual faculty or staff member, and by friends of the Bumpers College.
- The deadline for nomination materials will be announced each spring by the Office of the Dean.
- Nominations, up to age 40, will be considered for a period of three (3) years.

D. Nomination Packet and Selection Criteria

(Sections D 1-3 of the nomination must be limited to a total of three (3) pages.)

- 1. Biographical Information: Please provide the name, age, current title and affiliation, current position responsibilities, address and phone number of the nominee.
- 2. Significant Contributions: Include exceptional achievements in career, public service and/orvolunteer activities that bring honor to the Dale Bumpers College of Agricultural, Food and Life Sciences.
- 3. Education: List all degrees awarded to the nominee, where they were obtained and field of study.
- 4. Supporting Materials: Please provide a current and complete resume of the nominee to include training, experiences, and activities, etc.
- 5. Nominator Information: Provide the name, address and phone number of the nominator.
