1. Alternative Text

I have made sure to add alternative text to my graphs, charts, or images. Alternative text allows users to still access the content without seeing the visual.

2. Long Descriptions

I have made sure to include a long description to my complex image. A long description gives me an opportunity to fully describe what is taking place in my graph or chart. A long description can be included in the text around my chart and in the main body of my work.

3. Tables for Additional Clarity

I have included the same information in a table. A table provides users who are viewing your work with a screen reader the full ability to access the data you are presenting. Provide this table in your main document or provide an accessible link to this information.
