1. Display

2. Color and Color Contrast

3. Reading Order and Slide Titles

4. Alternative Text and Images

All my images have alt text or have been labeled as 'decorative'.

5. Links

All the links I have put in my PowerPoint are clear and descriptive.

6. Text

The color of my text contrasts with its background enough that it is easily readable and I have limited decorative fonts.
