By following this checklist, you can make sure that your tables in Microsoft Word follow Division accessibility requirements.

- I have identified the header and tabular data.
- I have added alternative text.
- I have added a table caption.
- My table is structured in a logical reading order.
- I have used the “Insert Table” tool instead of the “Draw Table” tool.
- I don’t have any nested cells, merged cells, or split cells.
- My table isn’t used for design layout.
